

Anas Jellouf also known by his artistic nickname, Sidi Blue Moon, is a sound artist, composer, and multi-instrumentalist whose work explores the connection between Moroccan musical traditions and contemporary sounds.

The univers of the artist offers an immersive journey between the past and the future by blending traditional Gnawa and Afro-Moroccan music with electronic elements.

At the core of the performance are traditional Afro-Moroccan instruments such as the Guembri, Ribab, Ngouni, and Ghayta. These instruments, deeply rooted in spirituality and rhythm, are played live to create a hypnotic and captivating atmosphere.

The aim is to preserve the essence of Gnawa music

deeply linked to trance and meditation - while incorporating modern electronic elements to enrich and intensify the sonic experience.










DISCOGRAPHY




Ziara Residency Gnawa Research and Creation (Dar Gnaoua, Tangier, 2023), supported by the Canada Council for the Arts. During this residency, he collaborated with traditional Gnawa masters and jazz musicians, notably Martine Labee on trumpet and Ahmad Azhar on guitar to explore and learn ancestral Gnawa rhythms and rituals through a contemporary, cross-genre approach

LEÑA Artist Residency (2025) Sidi Blue Moon was invited to the LEÑA Artist Residency, an artist-run, multidisciplinary space on Galiano Island, BC. Set within the unceded traditional territories of the Lamalcha, Penelakut, and Hwlitsum First Nations, LEÑA offers a rare environment for focused, selfdirected creative exploration, surrounded by forest and ocean. During his residency, Sidi Blue Moon immersed himself in research and sound experimentation, developing new compositions that bridge nature's resonance with electronic frequencies.
